



Middle School: Scholarship Information for Academic Year 2024-2025

The deadline for scholarship applications is **March 8, 2024**. Documents submitted with this Application Form must be in English. If any document is in a language other than English, a translation must be attached to the application. Middle school students must complete and submit the application themselves. Please note: parents must not complete the form on the child's behalf.

The awarding of scholarships will be decided by a Scholarship Committee which is appointed by the School. Scholarships will be given based on the applicant's academic excellence, as well as their contributions to the school and global community. The committee will evaluate the quantitative and qualitative data received from each applicant to make a decision, so it is important for students to put equal effort into each part of the application process. The committee will use all information provided in order to decide which applicant best fits the scholarship criteria. Student interviews may be requested as part of the selection process for finalist candidates.

All decisions regarding scholarships are final. No appeals or requests for justification will be accepted.

The Admissions Office will communicate the results of the application process directly with the parents of the applicants.

<p>Applicant Expectations</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student is expected to maintain good academic standing during the duration of their study • Student should have an exemplary behavior record and no issues of academic misconduct • Student must consistently demonstrate a positive attitude and maximum effort in their learning • Student must participate in the full school program, including field trips, extracurricular activities, etc. • Student must meet attendance requirements, not missing more than 10% of school days or have excessive tardies • Student should be a role model for younger students and embody the ISNS core beliefs
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Part 1: Scholarship Type and Criteria

1. **Middle School Learner Profile, Service, and Community Leadership (15,000 RMB):** Two scholarships will be awarded to students in Grades 6 to 7 who have best demonstrated the attributes of the IB Learner Profile and who are highly involved in the school community by providing service or as leaders.
2. **Middle School Overall Academic Achievement (40,000 RMB):** Two scholarships will be awarded; one to the top achieving student who applies in each grade level in Grades 6 to 7.
3. **Middle School Balanced Learner (20,000 RMB):** Two scholarships will be awarded; one to the top achieving and balanced student who applies in each grade level in Grades 6 to 7.

All applicants must provide the following documents:

- Online Application Form completed
- Re-Enrolment form on OpenApply has been completed.
- Personal statement including any achievements, awards, extra-curricular activities, and community service in the past year as it relates to the award you are applying for (1, 2, 3)
- Student's academic reports for the last twelve months
- Additional support documents for award(s) - supporting information about achievements, awards, extra-curricular activities, and community service in the past year. You are strongly encouraged to use the template provided for this

中学部：2024-2025学年奖学金信息

奖学金申请截止日期是2024年3月8号。随本申请表提交的文件必须为英文。如果任何文件是英语以外的语言，则必须在申请中附上翻译。中学学生必须完成并提交申请表。请注意，家长不得代表孩子填写表格。

奖学金决定将由学校任命的奖学金委员会做出，决定将基于学术成就以及对整个学校社区和全球社区的社会贡献。最终决定将基于从申请人那里收到定量和定性的数据来评估。因此，对学生来说，对申请过程的每个部分给予同等重视是非常重要的，因为委员会将结合所有信息来决定哪个申请人符合奖学金的标准。学生面试可能被要求作为筛选最终候选人的一部分。

3. **中学全面发展学习者奖 (20,000 元人民币)** : 6至7年级的学生中将有2人被授予此奖学金, 他们是每个年级申请的学生中最优秀和全面的。

- 个人陈述, 包括过去一年中与你申请的奖学金 (1, 2, 3) 有关的任何成就、奖项、课外活动和社区服务。
- 学生过去十二个月的学业报告。
- 额外的奖项辅助资料—过去一年的成就, 奖项, 课外活动和社区服务的辅助信息。我们强烈建议你使用申请表提供的模板来提交辅助资料。
